



Change 4 ENCORE:

God's plan that Christ be honored in the church today is to be accomplished by the ministry of the Holy Spirit. Jesus spoke of the Holy Spirit when he said in John 16:14, "He shall glorify me." The "Acts of the Apostles" is actually a book telling of the glorifying ministry of the Holy Spirit through believers. Every believer must be growing in the knowledge of the One who abides in the believer's heart and subsequently seeking to cooperate with His goal of honoring Jesus Christ. For this discussion we are going to concentrate on how believers cooperate with the Holy Spirit and how through Him you may have victory in the task of glorifying God.

- 9) What does it mean to walk in the Spirit (Galatians 5:16-26)?
- 10) How are we able to grow in righteousness as believers (Romans 8:13)?
- 12) The Holy Spirit is our Agent of change; what does the Holy Spirit use to change you?
- 12) What is the Holy Spirit called in John 14:16-20?
- 13) What else does the Holy Spirit help us with (Romans 8:26-27)?
- 14) What is the increasing / growing result of the Holy Spirit's work through the Word in the life of the believer (Galatians 5:22-23)?
