

Sweeter Than Honey

1. What does it mean to us that God's Word is "perfect"?
2. How does God's testimony make simple people wise? What do we need to do to obtain that wisdom?
3. How does God's Word give us joy? What happens to our outlook when we don't spend time in His Word?
4. Give examples of when God's Word has acted as a "light for [your] path," either to show the right path, or the dangers of the wrong path.
5. We are commanded to obey and worship God, even when He doesn't make sense to us. What are some situations in which this can be difficult? What are some ways to strengthen our faith in those times?
6. When does God's Word seem less valuable to us? Why does this happen?
7. What are some rewards of reading God's Word regularly?

Psalm 19:7-11 ⁷The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple; ⁸the statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes; ⁹the fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. ¹⁰More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. ¹¹Moreover by them Your servant is warned, and in keeping them there is great reward.

Sweeter Than Honey

Monday

Make time to read God's Word every day this week. At the end of the week, reflect on how this time in God's Word has impacted your life.

Tuesday

Write down something you learned from God's Word today.

Wednesday

According to the passage you read today, what is one thing God considers right? Take time to thank God for revealing this to you.

Thursday

Read more of God's Word. Has God used any passages to rebuke you for sinning? Confess and repent. Has God taught you something about Himself or what is righteous? Praise Him and start living it out.

Friday

Today take time to pray about what you have read, and sing a song of praise to God.

Saturday

Do you take God's warnings seriously? Are there some warnings from His Word that you have not heeded? Pick one of these warnings and start putting it into practice (e.g., "guard your heart with all diligence").
